Safe Water International Ministries (SWIM) is blessed to have incredible youth on their teams who are not waiting to improve the world. Their enthusiasm and desire to share the Good News through creating safe water is outstanding!

Below are just a few reports of how the youth are involved in making a difference with some of our SWIM teams.

**INDIA**

In a local youth group in India, the youth are being trained to make chlorine using the chlorine producing units (CPUs). They are so excited and determined to reach each household in their communities. They want to take care of every family and make sure each one has access to safe water every day.



Young women are making a significant impact in their community by becoming safe water professionals. They are promoting safe water practices and increasing access to clean water. Access is critical as contaminated water can lead to waterborne diseases which have serious health consequences, especially for children and the vulnerable population.



Another SWIM team has great fun teaching small kids and their parents about safe water and daily hygiene. As the future leaders, they are learning about the importance of safe water and Jesus as the Living Water.



## NEPAL

Youth volunteers in Nepal are showing students the love of Jesus with chlorine. They are building friendships and inviting kids to church to learn more about Jesus, while going door to door to share about safe water practices.

"The youth in the group were so excited! They asked for CPU training and how to share the Good News with their families and friends," Rich Grant, SWIM's board chair, said with a smile as he related a time he was in Nepal to distribute CPUs and encourage the SWIM team there. "The youth are a big part of this ministry."

When visiting different schools, the team shows the kids what the water bacteria looks like, along with the procedure to make chlorine. The kids are so intrigued to see what's happening under the microscope and to learn about safe water.



## UGANDA

The youth add a lot of value to the ministry, reported Juma, a SWIM team member in Uganda. They are helping to share the Gospel in their communities.

He reported that during their open air crusades, they make chlorine, serve in the church, do Christ missions, and give out Bibles. This is helping to prepare the next generation.

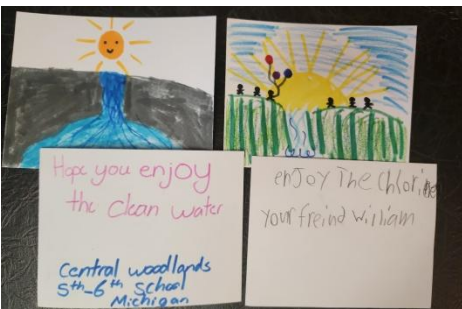
Recently, six communities were reached with the Good News of Jesus, along with being given CPUs!
